About MOMA Pre-Matric scholarship Scheme

Pre-Matric scholarship Scheme was formed to provide equal opportunity to the minority groups in the country. The scholarship scheme is carried out under Ministry of Minority Affairs (MOMA), established to provide financial aid to students who belong to the minority community (Muslims, Christians, Sikhs Jains, Zoroastrians (Parsis) & Budhists and from economically backward communities of the society. Under the MOMA Pre Matric Scholarship, the amount of Rs. 10,000 – 10,700 are distributed to the candidates whose family income is less than 1 lakh rupees per annum. Apart from renewal, 30 lakhs fresh scholarship are distributed under the Pre-Matric Scholarship. 30 % scholarships are reserved only for girls. - Under this Pre-Matric Scholarship scheme, the Ministry provides financial aid to children from class 1 to 10 studying in government or recognized private schools/institutes in India.
- Pre-Matric scholarship Scheme was started in the year 2008-09 to encourage parents to send their children to school and lighten their financial burden on school education.
- From the session 2012-13 to 2017-18, an amount of Rs. 5164.45 crore was released to benefits 3,40,56,999 students under MOMA Pre-Matric Scholarship.

MOMA Pre Matric Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

Gender Both

Region India

Class/Age Class 1-10

Parents Income: Students must belong to the economically backward class and the income of parents/guardians should not exceed a sum of Rs. 1 lakh per annum from all sources.

Must be from the minority community i.e. Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jains & Zoroastrians

Qualifying Marks: He/she must have attained at least 50 % marks in the previous examination.

The scheme will not be given to more than two students from a family.

The student availing scholarship under this scheme is not eligible for benefit under other scholarship schemes.

MOMA Pre Matric Scholarship Amount

The Scholarship will be disbursed shortly after the registration process will end. Pre-Matric Scholarship would cover two components course fee/tuition fees and maintenance allowance. Course Fee/Tuition Fees would be credited to the school/institutions account and Maintenance allowance would be given directly to the students.

The scheme will cover other allowances if the student lives in a hostel. The scholarship will be provided for the whole course The scholarship is subject to renewal and would be continued only if the student scores a minimum 50 % marks in the previous examination.

Documents to be uploaded from Pre-Matric Scholarship

The documents are required to be uploaded (for both Fresh & Renewal Scholarships) only if the eligible claim of the scholarship is more than Rs. 50,000 per student. In the case of pre-matric scholarship, the amount is less than Rs. 50,000 hence no documents are needed.

Documents needed for Verification of Online Application

The list of document to be submitted to the Institute/School/college by the student for verification of online application.

Student Photo. (Mandatory)

Institution Verification Form. (Mandatory) A copy of the form is annexed.

Income Certificate: Income Certificate of Parent/Guardian issued by the Competent Authority in the State Government is required (Mandatory)

Religion Certificate: Self Declaration of Community Certificate for Class I to 10 given by the Parent/Legal Guardian (Mandatory)

Mark Sheet: Self-Attested Certificate of 'Previous Qualifying Exam/Board Marksheet' as filled in the Form. (Mandatory).

Fee Receipt of 'Current Course Year'. (Mandatory)

Proof of Bank Account (Mandatory)

Residential/Domicile Certificate (Mandatory)

Your application must be verified at the Institute and Domicile District/Domicile State/UT level. You may contact the concerned verification authorities for online verification of your application within the timeline given on the NSP portal. Ministry of Minority Affairs will release the scholarship amount, only if your application is verified and approved by all verification authorities.

Steps to Fill the Minority Scholarship Application Form 2019

Registration: The candidates must register themselves first, and they must keep their registration number, email ID active during the entire process.

Details: The Candidates must fill the online application form very correctly with all the personal and academic details.

Upload documents: The candidates must upload the scanned copies of the document given below:

- Candidate's Self-Declaration of belonging to Minority Community Certificates
- Candidate's Self-Declaration of Annual income of family members
- Candidate's Scanned copies of identify proof
- Scanned Copies of Cancelled Cheque of Bank Account of the student
- Scanned Copy of an Affidavit on Non-Judicial Paper of Rs. 5 duly notarized
- Scanned copy of the Admit Card of the particular examination
- Scanned copies of the Roll number slip with a cop of result page

Save and submit: After the successful uploading of all the documents mentioned above, the candidates need to "Submit" button for the successful application process.

Submission of Minority Scholarship Application Form

While filling the application form, the candidates should make sure that the details filled by them are correct in all aspect. Otherwise, the application of the candidates may get rejected. The candidates need not submit any hard copy of Minority Application form along with the documents to the concerned authority. However, candidates are advised to take a printout of the application form for future use.

Minority Scholarship in India was started from the year 2006 when Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities was announced. It stated that scholarship scheme for meritorious students from the minority communities would be implemented in India.

- Minority scholarship is from pre-matric to doctorate level and encourages parents from minority communities to send their children to school/colleges/universities whatsoever is applicable.
- The minority scholarship grant is to reduce the financial burden on parents as well as the respective institution and sustain their efforts to support their children to complete education till the level they wish to.
- The scholarship schemes will form the foundation for their educational attainment and provide a level playing field in the competitive employment arena.

Minority Scholarship Eligibility

Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jains and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992. The distribution of scholarship among the States/Union Territories will be made on the basis of the population of minorities in the States/Union Territories of Censs 2001.

How Many students availed the Minority Scholarship in 2018

Total Students who have received the minority scholarship - As per Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi, Minority Affairs Minister, approximately 25.2 million students in past 4 years have availed the three scholarships - Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means based scholarships. Out of the total students, 50 % are girls.

In 2017-18: 600 million scholarships were provided under three schemes

Target of scholarship until 2020 – Next target of Minority scholarship is 700 million scholarships and the expenditure is going to be Rs. 53.88 billion.

MOMA Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme

This minority scholarship is provided by Ministry of Minority Affairs provide financial aid to students from Class 1 to Class 10 who belong to the minority community and are from economically backward families Under Pre-Matric scholarship scheme. It covers two components i.e. course fee/tuition fees and maintenance allowance and is directly credited to the bank account of the school. Ten months of maintenance allowance is also paid directly to students. Renewal is subjected to a minimum score of 50 % in the previous examination.

Apart from renewal, every year 30 lakhs new scholarships are provided to the candidates whose family income is less than 1 lakhs per annum, a further 30% scholarship is only reserved for girls. The scholarship amount under MOMA Pre Matric Scholarship is Rs. 10,000 – 10,700 per annum.

Ministry is making efforts for Direct Benefit Transfer under Pre-Matric Scholarship scheme by linking with parent's account under "Jan Dhan Yojana" as the younger children in schools do not have bank account. [Click here for complete details on MOMA pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme.](#)

MOMA Post Matric Scholarship scheme

This minority scholarship is provided by Ministry of Minority affairs provide financial aid to students from Class 11 (Studying in government or private schools) up to Ph.D level and who belong to the minority community and are from economically backward families. The full tuition fee of the course is covered and is directly credited to the bank account of the school/college/university/institution. Ten months of maintenance allowance is also paid.

Under MOMA Post Matric Scholarship, every year, 5 lakhs fresh scholarships are distributed to the candidates whose family income is less than 2 lakh rupees per annum. 30 % scholarship is also reserved for girls. The scholarship amount under this section is from Rs 5000 to Rs. 16,000 per annum.

Renewal is not subjected to any terms and conditions. Online scholarship Management was made operational for the post-matric scholarship since 2014-15. [Click to get complete on MOMA Post Matric Scholarship Scheme.](#)

MOMA Merit Cum Means Scholarships

Merit Cum Means Scholarships is commonly known as MOMA Scholarship is awarded to meritorious minority community students for pursuing their undergraduate and postgraduate courses like Engineering/Architecture/MBBS/Medical & Para Medical Courses/Veterinary Sc. & Animal Husbandry/CA/CS/ICWA/Fashion Technology/Design/Pharmacy/Law/Management/MCA.

Apart from renewal, every year, 60,000 fresh scholarships are awarded. 30 % of the scholarship is reserved for girls. The scholarship amount is Rs. 20,000 per annum under MOMA Merit cum Means Scholarship. The scholarship scheme is managed online since 2010-11. Maulana Azad National Fellowship for Minority Students

This minority scholarship is provided by Maulana Azad Education Foundation (MAEF), an autonomous body under the Ministry of Minority Affairs provide financial aid to Post Graduate students who belong to the minority community and are from economically backward families who wish to pursue higher studies such as regular and full-time M.Phil/ Ph.D. Degrees in Sciences, Humanities, Social Sciences and Engineering & Technology. The total fellowships offered are 756 out of which 35 are reserved for physically handicapped.

From 2018-19 session, the number of scholarships distributed to the candidates has increased from 756 to 1,000.

The maximum limit of family income is also increased from Rs. 2.5 lakhs per annum to Rs 6 lakh rupees.

Maulana Azad National Fellowship covers all Universities/Institutions recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and also which are not under the purview of UGC.

Maulana Azad Scholarship for Minority Girl Students

This minority scholarship is provided by Maulana Azad Education Foundation, and it offers the scholarship to Girl students belonging to National Minorities who have completed their secondary education and secured regular admission in class 11. Selected students will receive Rs. 12,000 each (Rs. 6000 in class 11 and Rs. 6000 in Class 12) as reward money. After successful completion of class 11, the scholars have to send the renewal form to the Foundation Office for availing the second installment of their scholarship i.e. Rs. 6000 in class 12. Nai Udaan Minority Scholarship

Nai Udaan Minority Scholarship is a scheme to support for Minority Students clearing Prelims of Group A and B (Gazetted and non-Gazetted post) of UPSC, SPSC, etc. conducted by Union Public Service Commission, Staff Selection Commission, State Public Service Commissions, etc. The candidates have to apply for Nai Udaan Minority Scholarship 2016 within 30 days from the date of announcement of the result of Preliminary Exam. Nai Udaan Minority Scholarship is given to up to maximum 800 candidates every year.

West Bengal Talent Support Stipend Minority Scholarship

West Bengal Talent Support Stipend Scholarship or commonly known as TSP is offered by The West Bengal Minorities Development and Finance Corporation, and TSP is one of the latest initiatives by Government of Bengal to provide financial support to the Minority Students of West Bengal who have passed their last final examination having less than 50% marks. In TSP scheme 30% quota has been earmarked for the girl student belonging to the minority group. The students eligible for this stipend will be awarded one time in a year.

Other Initiatives for the Minority Students by the Ministry

Padho Pardesh – An Interest Subsidy Scheme

It is a scheme under interest subsidy is provided on educational loans to minority students for higher studies. The scheme became operational through Canara Bank during 2014-15. Till December 2014, Rs. 2.28 crore has been released benefitting 573 candidates.

Fee Coaching and Allied Scheme

This scheme of the Ministry prepares the minority students for professional courses and higher services. Since 2007-08 till date, about 50853 students have been provided coaching in reputed institutions.

Financial Support for UPSC Exam

Financial support is also provided to minority candidates clearing Preliminary exams conducted by Union Public Service Commission (UPSC), Staff Selection Commission (SSC) and State Public Service Commission's (SPSCs).

Twelve candidates supported by the Ministry in 2013, were selected in the Civil Services Exams.

During 2014-15 till 19.12.2014, total 444 student have been awarded financial assistance for clearing Prelims exams conducted by UPSC/SSC and State PSCs and an amount of Rs. 128.50 lakhs was released.
